PROGRAM DELIVERY

Applicants choose specializations in either Primary/Junior (junior kindergarten to Grade 6 or Junior/Intermediate (grades 4 to 10). The two-year MT degree is composed of the equivalent of 16 half-courses (ten core, five specific, and one elective), including practica, and is undertaken on a full-time basis. In addition to the coursework and practica all candidates must successfully complete a comprehensive examination at the end of the program.

- The MT program is offered full-time and with a September start-date only
