



## Program of Study Application Closing Dates

December 1, 2009 is the deadline for submitting an application for admission, including all supporting documentation, to degree programs beginning in the 2010 Summer Session, the 2010 Fall Session and the 2011 Winter Session. While applications may be accepted after this date, no guarantee can be given that the application will be considered for admission to either degree programs, or courses, or for financial support.

If admission remains open, note the following secondary application deadlines:

March 5, 2010 (for 2010 Summer Session, *First Term* – May)  
May 7, 2010 (for 2010 Summer Session, *Second Term* – July)  
June 25, 2010 (for 2010 Fall Session – September)  
October 1, 2010 (for 2011 Winter Session – January)

All OISE programs are listed in the following chart (alphabetical order). Program information may also be further itemized by degree.

Some programs of study may have not yet set a closing date (“Pending”), and therefore new applications are currently permitted (in other words “Pending” means a program of study is presently open for new applications, but at the program’s discretion a closing date can be set at anytime).

Some programs of study are no longer considering applications for 2010/2011 (all sessions) as of the closing date specified (note a closing date may be in the future). The closing date is the final day (as of 5:00p.m.) to enter all required information via the University of Toronto, School of Graduate Studies on-line application system, and pay the non-refundable application fee plus non-refundable supplementary fee. Generally, all supporting documentation (including résumé, statement of intent, letters of reference, and official transcripts) must be received by the Registrar’s Office, Graduate Studies Admissions Unit no later than seven working days after the on-line application process is completed (including payment).
