The research project is an on-going study that examines students' language and literacy development through technologically rich assessment tools called BalanceAI and APLUS. BalanceAI is designed to support elementary school students and teachers while APLUS is intended to support international students' communication skills in academic settings. Both projects involve cutting-edge AI and ML applications to process and score students' performance data. We're currently examining the impact of the AI integration into teaching and learning. We're also investigating how students respond to diagnostic feedback provided by the machine.
