OBJECTIVES AND METHODOLOGY: This project is intended to identify international students' needs and develop systems to support them at OISE, University of Toronto. As a first step, we will survey students to understand their language needs, knowledge gaps, and awareness of resources around the campus. Building on the results from the first phase, we will develop digital modules, called iSSD@OISEUT. It consists of Engagement, Education, and Empowerment, each of which is designed to support students at different stages of their academic programs.

DESCRIPTION OF STUDENT PARTICIPATION: Students will participate in team activities involving literature review, instrument design, data collection at schools, and data analysis. Individual students will be paired with senior mentors in the lab and develop a research project based on their own research interest.

DAY AND TIMES OF LAB MEETINGS: My lab holds a research team meeting weekly and meet as a whole group monthly as well. Meeting dates and times are determined collectively when the semester starts.
