

Bill 143 – Child Care and Early Years Act

- Replaces the DNA and amends the Education Act, and ECE Act.
- Goals of program quality, access and flexibility and health and safety
- If not passed gov't will use regulatory and policy leavers.
 Changes would be phased in.
- Drivers are flexibility to align child care with School Board operated programs; ECE shortage for after school programs and oversight of the unregulated sector.



Education Act changes:

- Boards required to secure after school care for children 6 to 12 years but only on school days
- 7 day requirement to secure replacement care if an operator folds is removed
- Student identifier numbers are established for children attending early years programs
- Recommend:
 - School Boards be the first choice to provide extended day programming
 - Boards be allowed to provide internal fee subsidies



ECE Act: Stipulates the composition of the ECE College Council to align with OCT Act

Administration & Licensing:

- Province must consult with a Region before new licenses given
- Duty to cooperate in the development of regional children's services plans

Recommend

- Regions be designated as 'children's service managers'
- •Include 'Duty to cooperate' also be in the Education Act

The unregulated sector

- Requires license for private schools with extended hour programs; in-home nannies
- Prohibits providers/corporations with serious criminal convictions or record of professional misconduct from obtaining licenses
- Restricts misrepresentation of licensing
- Requires providers provide receipts



Health and Safety:

- Requires criminal reference checks for staff and unsupervised volunteers, members of provider households over 18
- Recommended CPR for CC staff & HCC providers
- Following updated Canada Food Guide



Home Child Care:

- CC providers may care for 6 (up from 5) children including their own < 6 yrs
- 2 providers may care for 12 children
- New home visitors require an ECE



Program changes

- Policy statement, applies to all ECE settings and ties ELECT/ELF principles to CC licensing
 - More descriptive about program of activities; replacing posted plans with parent interaction
 - · More flexibility for rest and outdoor play
