Early childhood education and learning supports within Manitoba government

- Early Childhood Education Unit (ECEU)
 - provides leadership and support to school divisions in the area of early learning for children up to age 8 years.
- Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) Branch
 - responsible for licensed infant, preschool, nursery and school-age child care

Healthy Child Manitoba Office

 works across departments and sectors to facilitate a community development approach for the well being of Manitoba's children, families and communities. The priority focus is on the prenatal period through the preschool years.

- Grant to school division based on Kindergarten enrolment
- Programming and services for preschool children (birth to 5 years)
- \$2.5 million for 2015/2016 school year
