#### **ABOUT THIS CHART**

This chart provides an overview of Kindergarten and Pre-Kindergarten programs across Canada's provinces and territories, highlighting key similarities and differences in how early learning is structured and funded.

It shows whether programs are publicly or privately operated, their typical schedules (full-day or part-day), the age groups served, and enrollment eligibility criteria. The chart indicates whether attendance is mandatory or optional and includes data on participation rates among eligible children.

In addition, it outlines curriculum and pedagogy guidelines, staff qualifications and roles, and whether programs receive federal support through the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) agreements. It also includes whether parents pay fees.

Overall, this chart is a valuable resource for policymakers, educators, and parents. It sheds light on regional differences, identifies service gaps, and highlights opportunities for improvement in early learning programs.
