

The OISE Scholarship Program for Indigenous Students includes two scholarships to be awarded annually to Indigenous students who are registered on a full-time basis in a graduate degree program at OISE. One scholarship will be awarded to an Indigenous student in a Doctoral program and one to an Indigenous student in a Master's program. This award is open to all Indigenous candidates at OISE (First Nations, Métis, Inuit and Indigenous Peoples from outside of Canada) with preference to applicants who have not previously been awarded this scholarship. Recipients will be selected on the basis of academic merit and previous and intended contributions to their community. Payment will be made in the Fall 2025 session.

**Value:** \$7,500 per recipient

**Application Deadline:** June 6, 2025, open to Master's students only.
