The purpose of this award is to support Masters and Doctoral students in graduate studies in education at OISE, University of Toronto. Specifically, the support is for assisting graduate students with the extra expenses involved in carrying out their thesis research. These students are focusing on their study on culturally oriented community organizations and their educational endeavours, or the educational roles of libraries, museums, galleries, conservatories, or voluntary associations. These students are examining the cultural context of a school community or educational communities; the ways in which schools, museums, libraries, and/or other similar community institutions or programs reflect or provide for ethnocultural diversity, or multiculturalism, antiracism, human rights, and equity, or Canadian culture. The criteria on which your application will be adjudicated are: clarity of intent and focus; the coherence of the proposal; relevance and applicability; originality and creativity; contribution to the state of knowledge and practice; evidence theoretical content and analysis; and feasibility.

Value: Based on the accrued annual income (\$12,000) which can be divided among multiple recipients
