The purpose of this award is to give support to students enrolled in graduate studies in the Department of Social Justice Education at OISE, University of Toronto. Priority consideration is given to students who are not eligible to receive the University of Toronto's guaranteed funding. Specifically, the Muriel and Danny Fung Graduate Award will be awarded annually to a student who is registered full time in the second year or later of their program and whose academic and community work promote racial equality and social justice. Applicants will be assessed on their academic record (grades and sample of writing), cover letter, evidence of community and commitment to create social change.

Value: Based on the accrued annual income (\$10,000) which can be divided among multiple recipients
